ART WALK AT RHEEM VALLEY

Moraga, California — Shoppers will find a gallery-like ambience at Rheem Valley Shopping Center as they stroll through art displays installed in available storefronts starting August 17, 2009. The artwork from nationally known bay area artists, many with studios in Lamorinda and Moraga, will offer shoppers interesting displays to enjoy while walking between the center's shops, services and restaurants.
